AFP Chapter *Membership Dues* Scholarship Application

Availability: There are 6 AFP membership dues assistance scholarships available annually. They fund 50% of individual membership dues in the first year (up to \$150) and 25% of dues in the second year (up to \$75). Member must request the second year payment. You need to provide AFP with a receipt for dues reimbursement.

Deadline: Applications are accepted throughout the year until all available funds are allocated.

Award Criteria: Applicant must be employed by a 501(c)3 organization with 5 or fewer fund development staff. Some preference will be given to applicants who volunteer for the local AFP Chapter.

Selection: Applications are reviewed by committee and notification will be made by letter, e-mail and/or phone.
